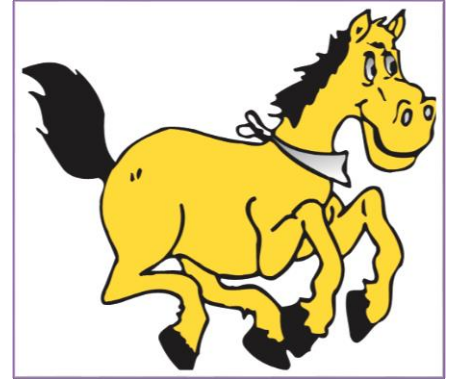
Hit the Ground Running
