We want to make sure that you knew about some of the dangers that are now simply a click away for our kids. Please be very aware of a particular **app** that has brought on numerous negative interactions and events at Sunset Park. That **app** is **TikTok**. First, children are supposed to be at least 13 years of age to access this to begin with. Second, they are potentially exposed to adult predators and finally much of the content is just simply not appropriate for children. One last thing is we want to make sure everyone is aware of the risks of sharing inappropriate materials along with the risks of long term damage and potential criminal ramifications that can come from sharing this type of material.
